WHAT WE SELL

1. Remediation Closure & Evidence Packaging

We take an existing POA&M, audit, or assessment finding set and drive it to closure: remediation planning, fix support, retest, and audit-ready evidence packaging per finding. Where Winquest performs the remediation, we deliver retest results and evidence, not a self-certification. Independent validation is offered as a separate, firewalled engagement on finding sets we did not remediate, or under a documented FAR subpart 9.5 mitigation plan.

Outcome: Findings close on a schedule you can report, with evidence that survives the next audit.

2. Requirements & Compliance Workflow Engineering

We configure JIRA or the platform you already own, for federal traceability: structured intake, ownership assignment, automated escalation, QA/QC gates, and real-time leadership dashboards.

3. Security Control Validation & Assessment

Veterans First set-asides take precedence over all other FAR part 19 set-asides, above and below the SAT.
- **SDVOSB sole source to \$5M.** Under 38 U.S.C. 8127(c) and VAAR 819.7008, VA may award sole source up to \$5M including options, with no finding that only one SDVOSB can perform. Requirement synopsis, FAR 6.302-5(c)(2)(ii) justification posted, firm found responsible.
- **Below the SAT:** direct award; quote returned within 5 business days.
- **Also available as a subcontractor** to primes needing SDVOSB participation credit.
